Large emergency vehicles or large city vehicles (ex waste management) cannot make the turns! Please park temporarily in the pull outs if needed. Parking is covered in the Covenants document.

<u>Title List of Board and Chairpersons with</u> Duties

Keep residents informed of all city/neighborhood events that may affect them. Encourage residents to contribute to a better neighborhood.

Treasurer -Deposits dues, pay all approved bills and give quarterly report to residents and yearly budget and report at annual meeting. **Social Committee** -Organize neighborhood gatherings. Annual block party?

Welcome Committee -Welcome all newcomers with info packet.

Community Policing and Block Captains-Take calls from neighbors about crimes and issues, then report to newsletter.

Newsletter Committee -Edits, collects, prepares articles for newsletter. Sets up and prepares newsletter for print.

Membership Committee -Works with Welcome Committee and President to keep track of residents and rentals.

Neighbor Care Committee -Send cards to residents as needed, find out if any resident needs assistance with groceries, services, etc. **Delivery Team** -Volunteers who help deliver, fold, copy, mail items for ANNA.

Beyond Our Walls -District 4 Coalition Representative of Neighborhood Association. Alert ANNA of things from city that effect ANNA.

Winter is a quiet time for the Beautification Committee, but spring (we hope) is right around the corner. The evidence of that is the many weeds showing up in yards around the neighborhood. Please manage your own weeds or find someone to do it for you. A weedy yard sends it's seeds next door and weeds proliferate. If you have a problem neighbor, report them to the City's 311 application on the city website. You may report them anonymously there.

Barstow maintenance has been taken care of by application of a pre-emergent to keep new weeds from coming up along Barstow and help keep further maintenance down over the summer months. This expense of approximately \$500 is paid for from the dues collected from owners.

We have had another quiet winter here at Academy North. If you see a crime call the police first, then let me know so I can log it. Friday, November 4, 2022 A possible homeless man was seen asleep, in a neighbor's front yard on a bench. 311 was called and they said they would notify ACF to send someone over to investigate. It is unknown if they ever came, but the man was seen later walking up Parrot Run to Leslynne then jump over the wall to the arroyo at the south end of the street. It is sad that we are dealing with this and hopefully it will be the last.

January, 2023

A window was broken out in a vehicle parked on Parrot Run during the night. Perhaps they were looking for something of value: cell phone, gym bag, money, tools, etc. Remember to take all valuables from your car if you park on the street. It is best to park in your garage or in your driveway if you possibly can. If you see anything out of the norm which doesn't seem right, please write down the important pieces of information such as a license plate, description of a person, time of day, etc. Let me know so that an alert can be put out to the neighborhood. If we are the eyes and ears for the police, we have a better chance of stopping a crime. Also, as the weather warms up we will have more walkers in the neighborhood. Please slow down as you drive along the streets. And finally, please light up your house with your porch lights. A brightly lit neighborhood is a deterrent for crime. It was reported two young people were seen late one night on Parrot Run near Leslynne hovering over a back pack acting suspiciously. APD was called. Please make sure your doors (including the garage, cars and windows) are locked every night.


Being Neighborly
